**Subject: Revised Graduation Requirements of Master's Program,
Independent Study (Plan B)**

In reference to the Ministry of Education on Graduation Curriculum Standard Criteria issued on February 21, 2005, the Graduate School of Education has changed the graduation requirements of Master's Program, Independent Study (Plan B) as follows:

1. Completion of all course requirements of the program with grade point average of 3.00 or more in the 4.00 system.
2. Pass the comprehensive examination.
3. Submit a portfolio of knowledge and experiences gained in the program in one's own format.
4. Submission of an independent study of 3-6 credits to the approval of 3 member committee, comprising:
 - a) The program director,
 - b) The major advisor, and
 - c) An inside reader selected from full-time faculty members
 - d) Dean's final approval in writing.
