

Rationale:

The Acts of the Teachers' Council and Educational Personnel stated that professional teaching is a required-approval career. The regulations of the Teachers' Council in granting a teaching certificate B.E. 2547 (A.D. 2004), Item 3, third paragraph states that a foreign person who applies for a teaching certificate has to pass a test and have measurement and evaluation knowledge according to the rules and procedures of the Teachers' Council. Thus, a training program has been developed for foreign teachers at the graduate level to fulfill the requirements for a teaching certificate in Thailand.

The Faculty of Education, Assumption University, has decided that it would be beneficial to offer this program to train foreign teachers. There are many foreign teachers in Thailand who are in schools, yet have not met the new standards of the Teachers' Council. In order to help improve the quality of foreign teachers in Thailand, we would like to contribute to their efforts by providing a training program.

Since our program is an international program and offers courses in English, we are in the best position to meet the needs of foreign teachers. Our faculty has expertise in teaching and learning for an international student body of diverse backgrounds. We believe that our expertise will make this training program the most beneficial one for foreign teachers.



Objectives:

The objectives of the program are:

- 1) To train foreign teachers in Thailand to understand the Thai society, career code of conduct, and be able to apply effectively their knowledge and experiences from the training to their teaching career.
- 2) To promote the reputation of the Faculty of Education and Assumption University as being an excellent international university.
- 3) To establish the Faculty of Education, Assumption University as the center of teaching careers for life-long learning.
- 4) To contribute to the Thai educational community.

Medium of Instruction

English

Qualification Requirement

Foreigners who have any background in Education and wish to pursue a teaching career in Thailand.

Selection Procedure

- 1) Submission of documentation
- 2) Interview

Training duration

4 days (total of 20 hours), approximately 1 month

Tuition Fees

8,000 baht per person in a group of at least 10.



Time Schedule for the training

The training program will be offered every semester (the seats are filled with at least 10 trainees.)

The class is scheduled only on Saturday from 9.00- 16.00 hrs.

Evaluation

Criteria for Grading

Evaluation from real practice	80%
Evaluation from tests	20%

Criteria for Evaluation

Passing Grade for individual subjects is 60% up. Grade will be "Pass" or "Fail"

Teaching Methodologies

Lecture, demonstration, stimulation and game, discussions, study tour, electronic aids, practice in real situations etc.

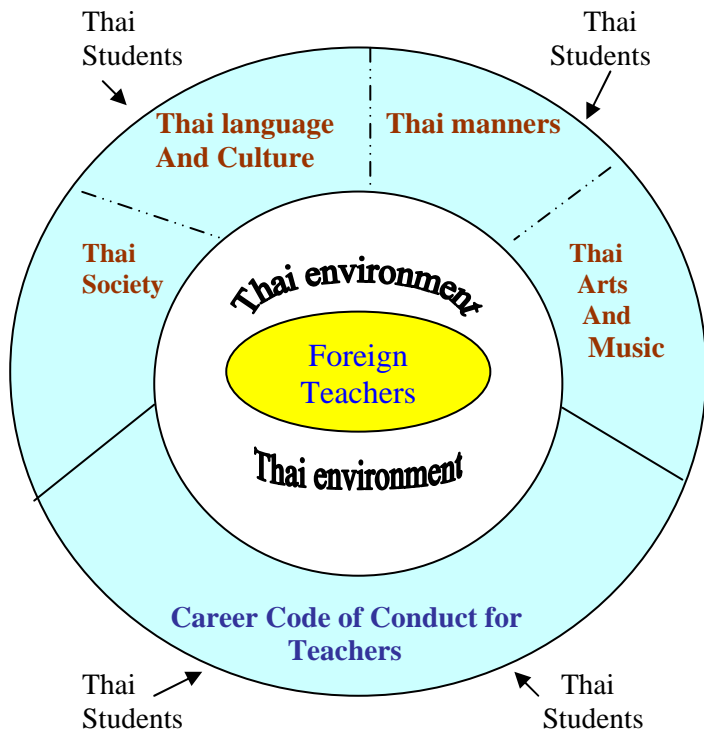
Certificate
